Coding Tip: COPD and Pneumonia Sequencing FY 2018. In this case, the coder would report J15.9 (Unspecified bacterial pneumonia) as the PDX. J44.0 (Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease with lower respiratory infection) would be sequenced as a SDX. In this case, the pneumonia is the condition that necessitated the admission and the condition that was aggressively treated. ICD-10-CM 2019 Chronic Disease Coding Cards. These coding cards provide a unique methodology for selecting the correct diagnosis code for commonly reported chronic diseases. Build a code in a compliant and efficient manner by navigating through a series of color coded choices. Once card users arrive at a green box, their code is complete. Diagnostic and risk-adjustment coding for chronic diseases is simple and easy when using the new ICD-10-CM 2018 Chronic Disease Coding cards. This series of cards best serves physicians, qualified health care professionals, and coders dealing with hierarchical condition category (HCC) coding and submitting claims to Medicare. The physician documents COPD with chronic bronchitis and emphysema in the record. Per Coding Clinic, Fourth Quarter ICD-10 2017 pg. 97, assign code J44.9, Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, unspecified. Code J43.9, Emphysema, unspecified, has an excludes1 note excluding “emphysema with chronic (obstructive) bronchitis.”
