

# Download Medical Decision Making A Physicians Guide

The translation of Medical Decision Making: A Physician's Guide into Portuguese has been published by Guanabara Koogan SA as Decisões Médicas Baseadas em Evidências ("Medical decisions based on evidence"), which is an interesting spin on the book. Medical decision-making in the paediatric population is complicated by the wide variation in physical and psychological development that occurs as children progress from infancy to adolescence. Parents and legal guardians are the de facto decision-makers in early infancy, but thereafter, the roles of parents/legal guardians and paediatric patients become ever more complex.
