6 A Parent's Guide. Sexual Abuse. When an adult or an older child uses his or her authority over a child to involve the child in sexual activity, it is sexual abuse, and that person is a child molester. The molester might use tricks, bribes, threats, or force to persuade the child to join in sexual activity. Other things are more difficult for us to discuss, including child abuse—especially child sexual abuse. Although discussing child abuse with your children may be difficult for you, it is very important. Perhaps the most important step parents can take to protect their children from abuse is to have open communication in the home. for parents about child abuse and some tips for talking with your child about child abuse.
