Other medical uses include suppression of diarrhea, replacement therapy for opioid use disorder, reversing opioid overdose, suppressing cough, suppressing opioid induced constipation, as well as for executions in the United States. Table 1 lists 17 GPCRs, all of which specifically recognize and bind to extracellular metabolites to elicit signal transduction mechanisms. These receptors belong to several different International Union of Basic and Clinical Pharmacology (IUPHAR)-classified GPCR families that include the free fatty acid (FFA) receptors and the hydroxycarboxylic acid (HCA) receptors (Blad et al., 2011 ...
