DID ROBERT FROST KNOW ANY INDIANS? My spouse, Diane, and I just spent our 25th wedding anniversary at an event at the American Academy of Arts & Letters in NYC. Contrary to popular perception, the Old West was much more peaceful than American cities are today. The real culture of violence on the frontier during the latter half of the nineteenth century sprang from the U.S. government's policies toward the Plains Indians. The book is a coming of age story, detailing Junior's life on the Spokane Indian Reservation, and his decision to go to an all-white public high school off the reservation.
