One useful tool, Norman Webb's Depth of Knowledge Levels, can help teachers meet that challenge. Depth of Knowledge (DoK) categorizes tasks according to the complexity of thinking required to successfully complete them. Level 1. Recall and Reproduction: Tasks at this level require recall of facts or rote application of simple procedures. The task does not require any cognitive effort beyond remembering the right response or formula. Referencing Depth of Knowledge levels should help you create an engaging classroom environment, filled with distinct thinking and learning experiences. Level 1. The first Depth of Knowledge level is defined as recollection and reproduction. Rooted in simple exercises and procedures, students must remember facts, terms and formulas. Webb's Depth of Knowledge. • Recall of a fact, information, or. Level 1 procedure. • Skill/Concept: Use information or conceptual knowledge, two or more. Level 2 steps, etc. • Strategic Thinking: Requires reasoning, developing plan or a sequence of steps, some complexity, more than one possible answer.
